

# Guidelines for Skill Refresher Course for Covid-19 Responder Practical Program

This guideline intends to facilitate qualified medical training centre or receiving COVID Response facility how to conduct the practical classroom portion of the Skill Refresher Course. It guides them how to deliver the course, what equipment to use, and allow the facility to use instructor course materials provided.

## 1. Classroom set-up

#### 1.1 Instructor to student ratio.

One instructor can deliver the course with maximum 5 students. The class can also be conducted with 1 student present.

## 1.2 Infection control protocol

As this course is being done in the midst of the Covid-19 pandemic, it is important to comply with safe distancing during the duration of this course. As well as wearing a facemask for both the instructor and the student. Student are required to perform hand hygiene before entering the classroom. Equipment are to be disinfected by the instructor after every practical session. It is also required to give each student one equipment if possible (e.g. OPA, NPA) and have it disinfected after the class. Alternatively, provide a disposable glove if using 1 equipment for all student.

## 2. Equipment

The following are the list of equipment needed to conduct practical session of the course.

- Blood-drawing needles
- Tourniquet
